



## Job Title – Electric Foreman

### Job Description + Responsibilities:

- Perform skilled and hazardous electrical work of the journeyman utility line worker level in construction, maintenance, inspection, and repair of the City's overhead and underground high voltage electrical distribution and street lighting systems, substations, and related equipment, including energized and de-energized lines safely and efficiently.
- Responsible for monthly meter reading.
- Public Relations: responsible for taking care of consumer complaints pertaining to the electrical department: Example high usage complaint, load management complaint, etc.
- Shall be the Administrative Official for the City of Howard's Zoning Ordinances.

### Qualifications (including education + certification requirements):

- GED Certification with a minimum of one year vocational/technical training from an accredited power line maintenance school.
- Four years of experience as an apprentice line worker with an electric distribution utility.
- Or any such combination of education, experience, and training as may be acceptable to the hiring authority.
- Must possess or be able to obtain a valid Class A commercial driver's license.
- Journeyman line worker certification required.
